
Dr. Manisha Kothekar Madam elaborated the personality development aspects of Spandan And development of leadership skills in medical students.


Dr. Devendra Ptil sir Director of student welfare section MUHS Nashik discussed the success of winners of previous Spandan in National and International Platforms.



Rules and Regulation: - Debate Competition


1. Only one team per college is allowed to enter.
2. Each team will consist of two contestants: one will argue in favor of the proposal, and the other will argue against it.
3. The competition will be conducted in Marathi, Hindi, or English. Both contestants must speak in the same language.
4. Reading from written material is not permitted.
5. Each contestant will have 5 minutes to speak, with a warning bell ringing after 4 minutes.
6. The topic for the debate competition will be announced one day prior, and this information will be circulated in the official WhatsApp group.

Rules and Regulation: - Elocution Competition

3. Each contestant will have 5 minutes to speak. A warning bell will ring after 4 minutes.
4. The topic for the Elocution competition will be announced one day prior to the event.

6. Speeches can be delivered in prose or verse form, but singing is not permitted.
7. There will be only one round for the Elocution competition.
8. Mobile phones are strictly prohibited during the event.

The event conducted in **two phases**:


Phase 1: Preliminary/Screening Round


- **Date:** 5th May 2025

 - Each team member will have to appear in a written test separately. A score of a team will be the average score of that team i.e. $(S1+S2+S3)/3$. If the students are less than three the average will be calculated accordingly. Every student in a team may get a different set of questions.



Final Round Details:


