

Transitional Curriculum 2025-26 Report

Date- 21st November to 5th December 2025.

The Transitional Curriculum for the newly admitted First BAMS (Minor Batch) at Govindrao Wanjari Ayurvedic College & Research Centre, Nagpur, commenced with an auspicious inaugural function on **21st November 2025**. The ceremony began with **Dhanwantari Poojan and Stavana**, invoking blessings for a successful academic journey. The Chief Guest, **Adv. Abhijit Wanajri**, secretary Amar Sewa Mandal delivered an inspiring address to the students. He was joined by **Dr. Brijesh Mishra**, Principal Shri Ayurved Mahavidyala Nagpur who also guided and motivated the new batch. The **Principal, Dr. Virendra K. Shah**, addressed both students and parents, emphasizing discipline, dedication, and the noble responsibilities associated with Ayurvedic education.

On 22nd November 2025, **Pretest** was conducted & newly admitted students were taken for a guided visit to the hospital campus, academic campus, and the central library. During the visit, students were introduced to various hospital departments, clinical facilities, classrooms, laboratories, and learning resources. The orientation helped them understand the institutional environment, academic infrastructure, and the healthcare services available within the campus.

The curriculum began on **24th November 2025** with an inspiring session by **Dr. Shrikant Hadole**, Associate Professor Dravyaguna Department Mulak Ayurved College Butibori, who emphasized the **science and spirit of effective learning**. This was followed by an interactive lecture by **Dr. Rajkumar Gupta**, HOD Darvyaguna Department Indutai Gaikwad Patil Ayurvedic College, focusing on **group dynamics and team building**. Students also participated in a Sanskrit orientation "Vadatu Sanskritam-1" conducted by **Dr. Usha Kalwale**, and later took the Anti-Ragging Oath administered by **Dr. Raviraj Pardeshi**, ensuring awareness of a safe and respectful campus atmosphere.

On the following day **25th November 2025**, **Dr. Sundarsingh Danga**, Principal Jupiter Ayurvedic Medical College guided students through the **diverse career opportunities in Ayurveda**, which was further expanded upon by **Dr. Ashwin Kate** HOD Sharir Kriya Department Indutai Gaikwad Patil Ayurvedic College in his session on **different professional avenues available after BAMS**. A Sanskrit session **Vadatu Sanskritam 2- Gitam Pathatu Sanskrutam, Parspara Parichaya**, continued to strengthen linguistic fundamentals, while **Dr. Dayal Bawankar** introduced students to the **study of Ayurveda and its core academic structure**.

The program on **26th November** began with a session by **Dr. Kalawati Dhok** on the **basic principles of Ayurveda**, followed by **Dr. Pallavi Ghuge's Introduction to Ayurveda history**. Another Sanskrit class **Vadatu Sanskritam 3- Sankhya Prayog** by **Dr. Usha Kalwale** helped students understand classical concepts, after which **Dr. Raviraj Pardeshi** briefed the batch on **Biomedical Waste Management**, an essential component of healthcare safety.

Continuing on 27th November, **Dr. Manisha Thakre** introduced students to **AYUSH-related bodies and regulatory systems**. After lunch, **Dr. Mohan Yende**, Principal Indutai Gaikwad Patil Ayurvedic College delivered an insightful session on **Time management and effective strategies for academic success**. This was followed by **Dr. Sandip Waghmare's** introduction to **Rachana Sharir**, which offered students an overview of basic anatomy. After that **Vadatu sanskritam 4- Samyaparichaya** session was conducted.

On 28th November, students began their day with a refreshing Yoga session conducted by **Dr. Aasha Ramteke**, aimed at promoting physical and mental balance by Yoga. **Dr. Minal Itankar** later guided students on **Goal-setting techniques**. This was followed by a Sanskrit class **Vadatu Sanskritam 5- Dinasya Paricharya** and an enlightening talk by **Dr. Raviraj Pardeshi** on the **Indian Knowledge System**, highlighting India's intellectual traditions and their connection to Ayurveda.

On 29th November, **Dr. Poonam Fulandi**, Associate Professor Sanskrit Department Mulak Ayurved College Butibori, conducted an orientation on Sanskrit, reinforcing its significance in Ayurvedic study. After lunch, **Dr. Avinash Karambhe**, Professor Balrog Department BMAM Nagpur motivated students through his talk titled "**Aspiration to Achievement - The Doctor Within You.**" Another Sanskrit session **Vadatu Sanskritam 6- Sharirasya Avayavanam Parichaya** was held, after which students received training in **Basic Life Support (BLS) and First Aid** by **Dr. Raviraj Pardeshi**, preparing them for emergency situations in healthcare.

The session on 1st December began with an informative lecture by **Dr. Virendra Shah**, on **Communication Skills and Personality Developments**, followed by a session by **Dr. Manisha Thakre** on **personal and professional codes of conduct**, focusing on ethics and professionalism in Ayurveda. A Sanskrit session **Vadatu Sanskritam 7- Vartman Rupaani, Bhootakal Rupani, Bhavishyakal Rupani** by **Dr. Usha Kalwale** continued the language training. Later, **Dr. Raviraj Pardeshi** delivered a session on **Research awareness and evidence-based Ayurveda**, guiding students toward scientific temper and inquiry-driven learning.



The session was well-received and highlighted the importance of interactive learning in enhancing comprehension and student engagement.

On 4th November, Dr. Amit Ahire conducted an enlightening lecture on Public Health and Ayurveda in the Community, emphasizing the role of Ayurvedic principles in promoting health and well-being at the population level. The lecture was followed by a reflection activity titled "Why I Chose Ayurveda", encouraging students to introspect and share their motivations for pursuing Ayurvedic studies. The session fostered thoughtful discussion and personal connection with the subject, enhancing both awareness and commitment among students.

The program concluded on 5th December 2025 with a Valedictory Ceremony Post test was conducted.
